


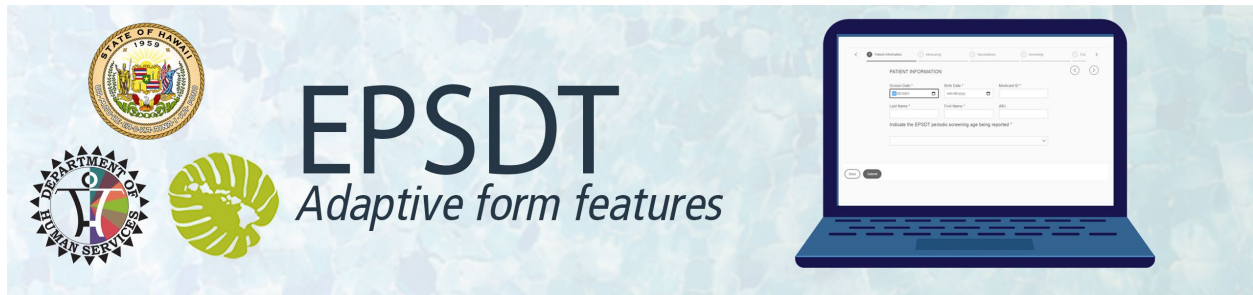


### Communication #3 – Adaptive Form Features

EPSDT providers will now have the option to submit EPSDT visit data online. When logged in to the Med-QUEST EPSDT portal, you can submit, save, and sign all in one place. Here are some of the features:

The Red 8015 and 8016 Forms are retiring at the end of 2021. \* Med-QUEST and QUEST Integration health plans will **only accept** the new 8015 or 8016 forms for EPSDT visits occurring on or after January 1, 2022.

\*note: Red 8015 and 8016 Forms must be used to submit EPSDT visit data for visits occurring before January 1, 2022.
