SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT UNDER THE MEDICAID STATE PLAN

EXPLANATION:

The State of Hawaii received approval from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services for State Plan Amendment (SPA) Number 21-0004.

This amendment creates a new eligibility group "Working Individuals with Disabilities" to keep Medicaid coverage by allowing a more liberal income and resource methodology. This amendment also clarifies that working disabled adults will not have any premiums or other cost sharing charges.
