Choice of Setting

Authority: 42 CFR 441.301 (c)(4)(ii)

Can I choose where I live?

Yes. The new federal rule says that you have a choice in where you live and have choices about who provides supports to you.

Why is this important to me?

You have choices about where you live, work, and receive services in the community.

You may make choices from among settings options.

Setting options are based on your needs and preferences. Options may include a non-disability specific setting and a private bedroom or living unit for residential settings.

The setting options that you explored shall be documented in your person-centered plan.

There may be limitations to choice of settings based on your assessed needs. Limitations will not be used without your (or authorized representative's) informed consent. Limitations will only be used where there is a health and safety risk and shall be documented in your person-centered plan.
