PROVIDER ENROLLMENT OF HOME AND COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES

(HCBS) PROVIDERS AND HOME HEALTH CARE AGENCIES

The purpose of this memo is to inform our health plans and providers of Home Health Agency (HHA) services and Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) of Medicaid enrollment requirements that are effective immediately. HHA and HCBS Medicaid providers are required to have a separate Medicaid provider number for each of the following services offered:

- Home health agency services;
- 2) Personal care attendant services;
- 3) Private duty nursing services and;
- 4) Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (I/DD) waiver services.

Each service corresponds to the provider type listed below:

Provider Type 23 = Home Health Agency
 A home health agency licensed and/or certified by the Department of Health and provides skilled nursing services, home health aide services and other therapeutic services such as

physical therapy, occupational therapy, and speech therapy under a physician's direction on a part-time or intermittent basis.

- 2) Provider Type 24 = Personal Care Attendant A home care agency which provides services such as companion, chore, homemaker and personal care assistance to assist the member with activities of daily living and/or instrumental activities of daily living.
- 3) Provider Type 46 = Nurse- Private (RN/LPN)
 A home care agency which provides private duty nursing services not covered by a home health agency.
- 4) Provider Type H1 = DD/ID A provider agency which furnishes services including but not limited to chore, personal care/habilitation, nursing and respite services to participants under the I/DD Waiver.

Appendix A has more detail on these four provider types.

Providers of HCBS and/or HHA services operating in several locations spread over one island or several islands are not required to have separate Medicaid provider numbers for each location.

To obtain the necessary Medicaid provider ID number(s), providers must complete the DHS 1139 Form for each provider type service you offer. The DHS 1139 form and instructions are available online at:

In situations where a provider has multiple Medicaid provider numbers:

- 1) Health Plans must prior authorize the service using the provider ID relating to the provider type.
- 2) Providers and agencies must bill for services using the provider ID relating to the provider type.
