SUBJECT: ELECTIVE CAESAREAN SECTION – NOT COVERED

The purpose of this memorandum is to notify the health plans that this memo replaces BEN-1101 which was previously issued on November 17, 2011. The following updated content will apply under the QI contract RFP-MQD-2021-008.

The purpose of this memo is to serve as a reminder that only medically necessary healthcare services are covered under our programs. Elective services are not covered. Accordingly, elective Caesarean section is not a covered service.

Elective Caesarean sections scheduled too early can result in a higher likelihood of newborn death, the newborn being admitted to a Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU), and life-long health problems for the newborn. There is an elective births measure (PC-01-AD) that is part of the CMS Adult Core set.

We appreciate health plan efforts to reduce the rate of inappropriate Caesarean sections and to prevent iatrogenic prematurity.
