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ELECTRONIC VISIT VERIFICATION (EVV)

updated August 13, 2018

What is EVV? EVV electronically captures point of service information for certain home and community based services. The 21st Century Cures Act, passed by Congress in December 2016, requires states to implement EVV for personal care services by January 1, 2020 and home health care services by January 1, 2023. The EVV system must electronically verify:

- **Type** of service performed
- **Individual** receiving the services
- **Date** of service
- **Location** of service delivery
- **Individual** providing the service
- **Time** the service begins and ends

Proposed EVV design - Med-QUEST Division (MQD) and Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS) are working together to implement EVV. The plan is to implement one state-wide EVV system. Existing provider EVV systems may be maintained as long as they meet system requirements and can interface with the state system.

EVV timeline – *tentative timeline is subject to change*

- September 2018 – Release request for proposal (RFP)
- January 2019 – Vendor selection
- April 2019 – Award contract
- October 2019 – Implement EVV for both personal care services and home health care services
