*****NPI CONTINGENCY PLAN IS ALMOST AT AN END*****

This is a reminder to Provider Memo ACS M07-21 dated November 21, 2007 regarding Fee for Service (FFS) claims submitted to the Medicaid Fiscal Agent, ACS. **Effective May 23, 2008 all provider claims must be submitted with the provider NPI number. Claims submitted without the NPI will be denied.**

Med-QUEST Division (MQD) will require the use of two new claim forms. The UB-04 will replace the UB-92 and the CMS 1500 (08/05) will replace the CMS 1500 (12/90). **After May 22, 2008 claims submitted using the old claim form(s), will be returned to the provider (RTP'd) without review.**

DO YOU HAVE YOUR NPI? SHARE IT!

That time is almost at an end, and now is your time to take immediate action. It is imperative that you **forward the enumeration letter** that NPPES sent you on to MQD. Failure to forward your enumeration letter will result in the denial of your claims at the end of the contingency plan period. If you have your NPI enumeration letter, and have yet to submit it, you have the following options:
